LIST OF WHAT TO BRING AND NOT BRING

The Following Items are things you will need to bring to school:

- Bible
- Back Pack
- Toiletries: Including toothbrush, toothpaste, hairbrush/comb, razor, shampoo, conditioner, soap, deodorant, feminine products (pads/tampons), bug spray*, sunscreen*, shower caddy*
- Shower Shoes (flip-flops)
- Towels & washcloths/loofah
- Blankets/Comforter/Sheets (long twin size), Pillows and pillowcases
- Hangers
- Laundry bag/hamper/Laundry detergent/dryer sheets
- Water bottle
- Sleeping Bag
- Tissues
- Small trash can
- Umbrella
- Fan
- Clock radio
- Flashlight & batteries
- Swimming Towel
- Bathing suit - (one-piece or tankini -modest and dean approved)
- Removable wall mounting strips/tabs/hooks
- School Supplies (See Official List provided by Administration)

Optional Items:

- Cell phone
- Mini Refrigerator \$30 annual fee
- Microwave \$30 annual fee
- Camera
- Air freshener
- Flash drives
- Plastic dishes
- Snacks
- Bottled Water
- Foot powder

- Headphones

- Hair Dryer
- Desk lamp
- Camera
- Curtains (windows are 43" wide)
- Area throw rug
- Room decorations that promote positive Christian values
- Appropriate reading material
- Curling Irons and Hair Straighteners (must stay unplugged when not in use)

Recommended Items NOT to bring:

The Following items are prohibited in the dorm for safety reasons. If found they will be confiscated and either held by the dean or disposed of:

- Pets - no students are allowed to bring their pets.
- Jewelry - is not allowed
- Fireworks, matches, incense, lighters, candles, or anything with an open flame of any kind.
- Weapons of any kind, including but not limited to knives, swords, staffs, nunchucks, throwing stars, nerf guns, paintball guns, airsoft & BB guns, pepper spray, mace, tasers, or firearms of any kind (including toy guns).
- Electric heaters (the only acceptable kinds of heaters are the oil filled radiator style heaters)
- Hot plates, coffee makers, electric grills, waffle makers, rice cookers, or any other items (besides a microwave) that heats food. (If you want to bring one of these items, you must have the dean's approval, and items must be turned into the dean to be checked out for dorm kitchen use only.)
- Irons may be brought but are kept in the dean's office and used in an approved area. They cannot be kept in dormitory rooms. No Electric Blankets or extension cords (a single plug strip per outlet is acceptable)
- Power tools, drills, saws, nail guns, hammers, screw drivers, and other tools are not allowed in dorm rooms. If there is a need for a student to use a tool it should go through the dean on duty
- Alcohol, tobacco or any associated products, drugs of any kind, as well as drug paraphernalia (including pipes, bong, or clothing items, stickers or pictures of marijuana leaves or other drug related items) Vaping and any related products.
- Bicycles, Scooters, hoverboards, skateboards, roller skates, or any other wheeled transportation devices are strictly prohibited inside the dorm at all times.
- No unclean meats are allowed in the dormitory or on campus. We serve a vegetarian diet on our campus for health reasons and we encourage our students to eat vegetarian also. No meat is allowed to be cooked in the dorm in rooms or kitchenette.

*Food items may be kept in rooms as long as they remain in sealed containers while not in use. Dirty dishes or other food related items cannot be left in dorm rooms. Dishes are to be washed in the large sink in the senior bathroom. Do Not Use the regular bathroom sinks for washing your dishes.

Finally, students are asked NOT to bring personal computers/laptops, tables, more than one phone, or gaming systems. Any of these items will be held by the dean if brought.
